From time to time the courts do not publish sufficient significant cases to warrant a revision packet. For this reason, you will not be receiving a May 2018 revision packet. You will receive Revision No. 195 in July.

The following United States Supreme Court cases will be incorporated into Revision No. 195. They are included here so that you have the advance citations for the new high court decisions.

- *Byrd v. United States* (2018) 138 S.Ct. 1518. The unauthorized driver of a rental car, who was alone in the car with the absent authorized driver's permission, could challenge the search of the rental car interior and trunk after a traffic stop.
- *Collins v. Virginia* (2018) 2018 WL 2402551. Officers could not enter the enclosed portion of a driveway that was within the curtilage to look under a tarp to obtain the license plate number and VIN of a stolen motorcycle.
